RENEWAL OF AUTHORIZATION BY SPCB FOR OCCUPIERS OF FACILITIES FOR GENERATION, STORAGE AND DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS WASTE

2. The Occupier of **M/s. JSW Energy Limited**, 860 MW Power Plant, PB No.9, Toranagallu, Sandur Taluk, Bellary District-583123 is hereby granted an authorization for generation, storage and disposal under Rule 5(4) of Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 as amended up to 2010 for **handling Hazardous Waste** in the manner indicated below while carrying on the activity of Power Plant (2*300 MW) and (2*130 MW)
3. The authorization granted to operate a facility for generation, storage and disposal of Hazardous Waste as indicated below.

5.1	Used Oil Transformer oil	60 KL/A 42 KL/A	Shall be collected in Leak proof containers and disposed only to KSPCB registered reprocessors provided the oil meets the standards as per schedule-5 of the Rules
5.2	a) Oil Soaked Cotton waste b) Used Filters	3.5 MT/A 100 No's/A	Stored in a secured manner and handed over to KSPCB Authorized incinerator/co-incineration in cement kiln

4. This authorization is issued with reference to the application dated 06/05/2015 and will be in force for a period from **1/07/2015 to 30/06/2020** ("This Authorization is valid only when the Consents are valid").
5. The authorization is subjected to the conditions stated below and such conditions as may be specified in the Rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF AUTHORIZATION

1. The person authorized shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules made there under.
2. This authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an Officer authorized by the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous wastes without obtaining prior permission of the SPCB/PCC.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorization.

5. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.
6. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made 60 days before the date of expiry.
7. Any other conditions for compliance as per the guidelines issued by the MoEF or CPCB.
8. The Person authorized shall take steps for reduction and prevention of the waste generated or for recycling or reuse.
9. The occupier generating the Hazardous waste specified in schedule -IV may sell it only to the recycler having a valid registration from the State Pollution Control Board for recycling or recovery.
10. The person authorized shall maintain the record of hazardous waste handled by him at site in Form-3 and prepared and submit an annual returns to the SPCB contains the detailed in Form-4 within 30th day of June following to the financial year to which that return relates.
11. The transport of hazardous wastes shall be in accordance with the provisions of these rules and the rules made by the Central Government under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and other guidelines issued from time to time in this regard.
12. The occupier shall provide the transporter with the relevant information in Form 11, regarding the hazardous nature of the wastes and measures to be taken in case of an emergency and shall mark the hazardous wastes containers as per Form 12.
13. **The Person Authorized shall not store the Hazardous Waste more than ninety days as per Rule 7 (1).**
14. **Display Boards**
The person authorized shall display sign boards at the storage site as "Hazardous Waste Storage Site" and "Danger" and the site shall be provided with accident preventive measures.
