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JSW Foundation works closely with farmers across India to strengthen agri-livelihoods through value chain development, adoption of sustainable farming practices, capacity building, and improved market linkages. In partnership with Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs), the Foundation has supported thousands of farmers, helping reduce input costs, improve productivity, and enhance income security.

SCALING WITH PURPOSE

Empowering farming communities

In Ratnagiri, JSW Foundation promotes organic farming, medicinal plant cultivation, and dairy development. The initiative currently supports 859 farmers who are engaged in organic and medicinal farming and cultivate 225 hectares of land. In Gir, 40 farmers are engaged in dairy farming, selling ~600 litres of premium A2 milk daily.

In Himachal Pradesh, the Foundation supports community apple orchards in Sholtu and Kutehr and more than 2,000 apple plants are currently nurtured on Gram Panchayat land.

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Fisheries and employment-linked skills

In Jaigarh, 159 individuals from fishing communities supported through open sea cage farming and seaweed cultivation. The projects were implemented under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in collaboration with the Department and College of Fisheries, Ratnagiri.

At Paradip Port, 22 youth employed in cargo handling jobs under the Foundation's employment-linked skilling initiative.
