2. The Occupier of **Occupational Health Centre of JSW Energy Ltd.**, is hereby granted an authorization to operate a facility for Generation, Segregation, Collection Reception, Storage, Packaging, of Bio-Medical Waste in the premises situated **Post Box No.9, Toranagallu, Ballari.**

3. **M/s Occupational Health Centre of JSW Energy Ltd., Post Box No.9, Toranagallu, Ballari,** is hereby authorized for handling of biomedical waste as per the capacity given below:

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4. This authorization is granted to the above Health care establishment for Generation, Segregation, Collection, Reception, Storage, Packaging, of the above categories of Bio-Medical Waste as indicated in **Annexure-I**. The Bio-Medical Waste generated as per Annexure shall be handed over to common Bio-Medical Waste treatment facility namely **M/s Suryakanth Environmental Technologies, Haraginadoni Village, Ballari Taluk and District.**

5. **This authorization shall be ONE TIME as per Board Office Corrigendum No.2739 dtd. 10-08-2016.**


6. This authorization is issued subject to the terms and conditions stated in **Annexure-II** (schedule-I of part 1 and part 2 of rules) and to such other conditions as may specified in the Rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

## ANNEXURE-II

### Terms and condition of Authorization:

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the prescribed authority.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the biomedical wastes without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of his authorization.
5. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
6. The occupier is required to ensure that, discharge of liquid wastes is in compliance with the standards stipulated in the said Rules. As per **Annexure-III**.
7. The applicant shall segregate the biomedical waste as per the Rules at individual ward level before handling over to common biomedical waste treatment facility.
8. Hospital authority/applicant shall maintain the records and log book regarding generation and disposal of different categories of biomedical waste in the hospital on a day to day basis.
9. The applicant shall display Charter on implementation of Bio-Medical Waste (M&H) Rules to the public in the hospital.
10. The Hospital Authority shall segregate Mercury waste from the Bio-Medical stream and same shall be stored in a secured place before its disposal as per relevant statute.
11. The applicant shall display this authorization at a prominent place like reception/entrance Etc.,
12. The applicant shall ensure compliance to all the applicable provisions of bio-medical waste management, 2016 rules.
13. The applicant shall make an application for authorization at least 90 days before expire of the authorization.
14. The occupier shall comply with duties of the occupier as mentioned in Rule 4 of the said Rules.
15. **The hospital authorities shall submit the Annual Report in Form – IV before 30<sup>th</sup> June for the period January to December of every year, prescribed format is enclosed.**

### ANNEXURE-III

#### STANDARDS FOR LIQUID WASTE

The effluent generated or treated from the premises of occupier or operator of a common bio medical waste treatment and disposal facility, before discharge into the sewer should confirm to the following limits:

#### PARAMETERS

#### PERMISSIBLE LIMITS

pH	6.5-9.0
Suspended solids	100mg/1
Oil and grease	10mg/1
BOD	30mg/1
COD	250mg/1
Bio-assay test	90% survival of fish after 96 hours in 100% effluent.
